Judge Gregory D. Brandt becomes Eminent Supreme Archon

On June 22, 2019 at the Sigma Alpha Epsilon 163rd Biennial

Anniversary Convention in Louisville KY our Iowa Delta brother, Greg Brandt '84, was elected and installed as our national fraternities Eminent Supreme Archon. Greg becomes the 3rd Iowa Delta Alumnus to rise to the title of ESA in our fraternity. He follows past ESA and Iowa Delta brothers Roy L. Miller who served from 1967-69 and Louis E. Smith who served from 1977-79.

Greg has spent his lifetime committed to SAE from the moment he was initiated in the Spring of 1984. As a pledge in the fall of 1983 he was elected Eminent Deputy Archon of the chapter. He has held every position on the Iowa Delta Alumni Association and House Corporation as well as being the Chapter Advisor for many years. On a national level he has served as Province Tau Archon, a member of the Fraternity Laws committee, on the faculty of the John O. Moseley Leadership School and a director on the Financial & Housing Corporation.

He began his official trek to becoming ESA in 2011 at the national convention when he was elected to the Supreme Council as the Eminent Supreme Chronicler. Over the next 8 years at each biennial convention he was elected to the next Supreme Council position ascending up the ladder towards the highest position in our fraternity.

In Greg's speech at the closing banquet he shared his vision for the growth of SAE over the next

biennium. He sees growth as much more than recruitment of members and expanding chapters to more campuses. Growth in education, programs and services provided by the fraternity are keys to strengthening SAE both for our undergraduate members and our alumni. Growth is also about brothers and utilizing the True Gentleman in our daily life.

Several of our Iowa Delta brothers and their wives traveled to

Louisville and were honored to be in attendance to celebrate Greg's election and witness his swearing in and acceptance speech at the conventions closing banquet.

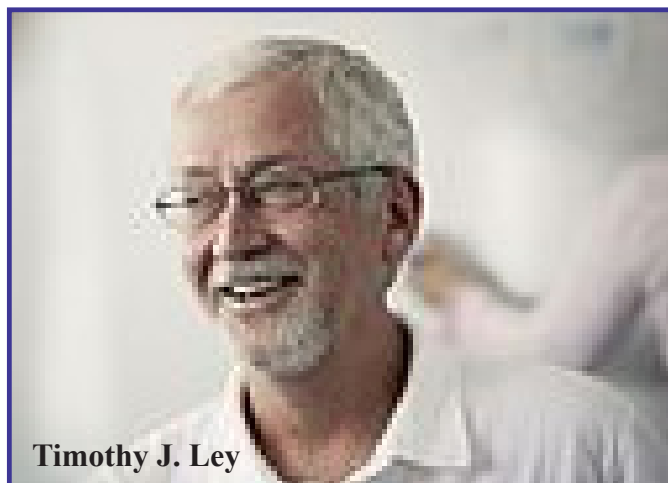
National Academy of Sciences Elects New Members and Foreign Associates to its Membership

The National Academy of Sciences announced today the election of 100 new members and 25 foreign associates in recognition of their distinguished and continuing achievements in original research.

Those elected today bring the total number of active members to 2,347 and the total number of foreign associates to 487. Foreign associates are nonvoting members of the Academy, with citizenship outside the United States.

Congratulations to Dr. Tim Ley MD, LA'74, (Iowa Delta) who was inducted into the National Academy of Sciences on April 30, 2019. Tim, a Hematologist and Cancer Biologist, received the Drake Alumni Achievement Award in 2010. At Washington University in St. Louis, he is the Lewis T. and Rosalind B. Apple Professor of Oncology in the Department of Medicine, is Chief of the Section of Stem Cell Biology in the Division of Oncology and is Professor of Genetics. He also is Associate Director of the [McDonnell Genome Institute](#) at Washington University and is affiliated with the [Alvin J. Siteman Cancer Center](#).^[1]
