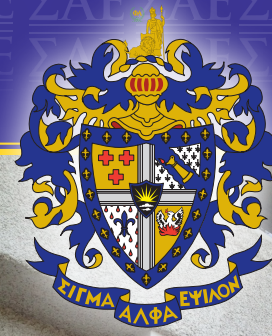

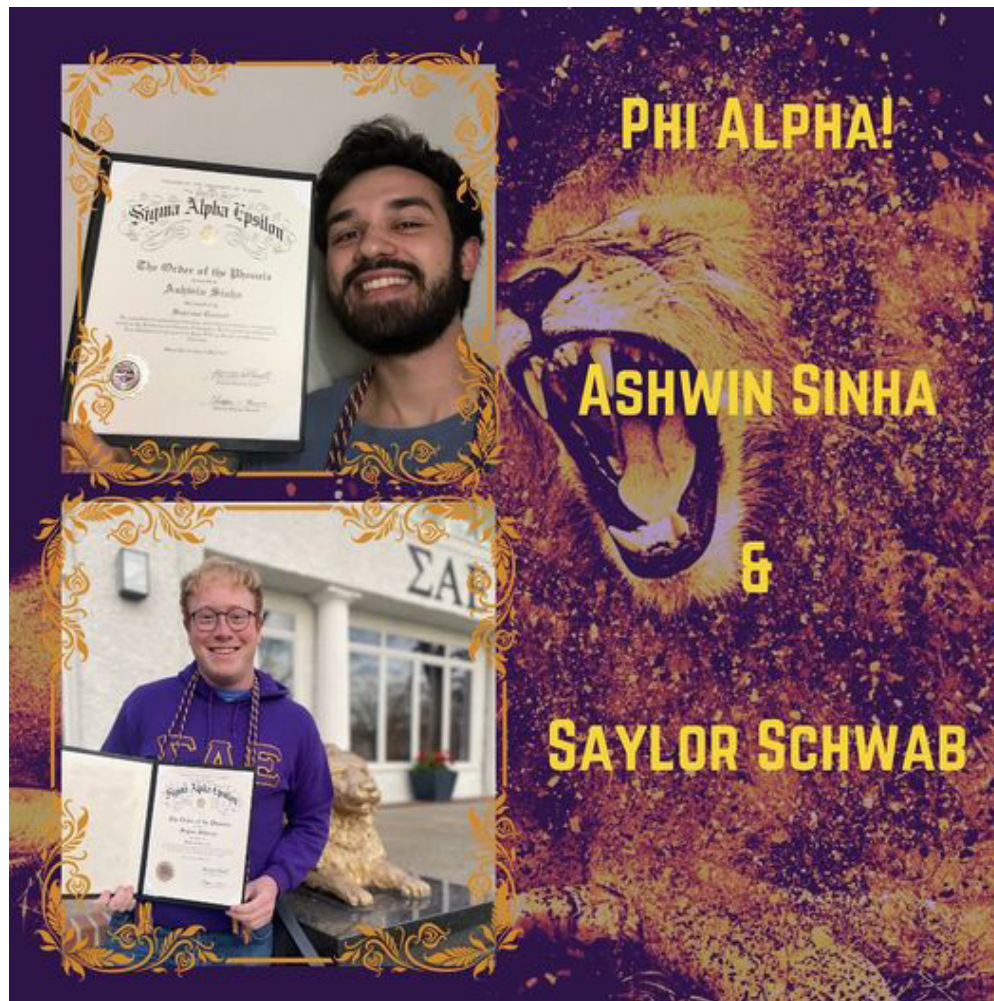

BROTHERS CELEBRATE IOWA DELTA'S 100TH ANNIVERSARY AT DRAKE UNIVERSITY

On April 29, 2022, 135 brothers and guests gathered at Des Moines' Wakonda Club to celebrate a very significant milestone – the 100th Anniversary of Iowa Delta. It was an evening to reconnect, reminisce, and acknowledge the lifelong bonds of friendship formed over the last 100 years.

As Chair of this event and emcee for the evening, it was our hope that attendees would leave more informed, highly inspired, and certainly entertained. Based on feedback, our objectives were clearly accomplished.

After a social hour and delicious buffet dinner, the evening's program kicked off with a specially developed video (see video link at end of this article) highlighting many of the changes and activities taking place on college campuses and within our fraternity. This look-back in time recognized that change has always been constant, but what has never changed has been the enduring friendships with our brothers.

The video, entitled "100 Years of True Gentlemen," showed a variety of photos from the last 100 years of Iowa Delta. Included were photos of the four different houses we occupied, demolition of the beloved Barn, and the addition of the Crist House and Bennett Bridge. We also highlighted the many accomplishments of Iowa Delta brothers over the years, including achievements in academics, leadership, social activities, Drake Athletics, and intramural sports.

We then heard from a group of brothers who shared updates on a number of house related activities, beginning with Eric Weiderin (2023), Iowa Delta's then Eminent Archon. Eric reviewed current house initiatives, including

scholarly, recruitment, and leadership accomplishments.

Greg Brandt ('81), then shared his leadership experience on Sigma Alpha Epsilon's Supreme Council over the last 10 years, including serving as the Eminent Supreme Archon for the last 2 years. Greg provided great insight into how our fraternity operates on a national basis.

A very emotional part of the program was hearing personal reflections from the following 5 attendees, who shared some of their favorite memories of being an Iowa Delta brother. They also uniquely touched on the importance of lifelong friendships they've made and retained over the years.
